

GREENFIELD VALLEY TRUST ANGLING RULES

RULES

1. Fishing is permitted on the Flour Mill Pool only. There is no fishing beyond the Weir Wall.
2. No fishing other than with rod and line.
3. Fishing between 8am and dusk only.
4. NO NIGHT FISHING.
5. All Anglers must hold a current Environment Agency Licence (not required by under 12 year olds).

CODE OF CONDUCT

6. All Anglers are required to show due courtesy to other Anglers and users of the Heritage Park and residents of property bordering the Flour Mill Pool.
7. All Anglers are empowered to act as bailiffs and to act with due care and attention to enforce these rules.
8. No TENTS or BIVIES to be erected.
9. No radios or televisions should be used.
10. All litter must be removed from the pegs and placed in the bins provided.
11. The consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited. Offenders will have their season ticket revoked.
12. Season tickets are non transferable.
13. All Anglers agree to abide by the Greenfield Valley Health and Safety, Child Protection and Equal Opportunities Policies.

JUNIORS

14. Juniors must have written permission from parents/guardians to fish. Parents must sign the season ticket application to this effect.
15. Juniors become seniors at the age of 17 years.
16. All Anglers under the age of 8 must be accompanied by a responsible adult (over 16) at all times.

ANGLING CONDUCT

17. A maximum of TWO rods only to be used by any one Angler at any one time. Baited hooks are not to be left unattended in the water at any time.
18. Barbless hooks are to be used at all times.
19. All Anglers must have their own landing net.
20. Fish are not to be kept in the keep nets for longer than 6 hours and fish must be swum through the net carefully on release. All nets must be a minimum of 2.4 metres in length. BREAM and SKIMMERS must not be put in keep nets.
21. All fish caught are to be returned alive to that same water.
22. No "fixed lead" or "bott rigs" are to be used.
23. Unhooking mats are to be used for carp fishing.

BAIT

24. Bait restrictions are as advised on the Notice Board alongside the Flour Mill Pool. Anglers should ensure they check the restrictions current on the day before fishing.
25. Live baiting and use of artificial lures is not permitted.
26. No floating baits are to be used.
27. No nut and seed baits are to be used.
28. Shop bought bolies are allowed, but only in conjunction with hookers, stringers and P.V.A. bags, with the exception of sweet corn and well cooked hemp.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND GREENFIELD VALLEY TRUST AUTHORITY

29. The Greenfield Valley Trust do not hold themselves responsible for any personal injury suffered by, or damage to, or loss of personal property, to any person or persons in connection with any angling activities.
30. Every Angler (season and day ticket) shall accept the rules under penalty of expulsion. The Greenfield Valley Trust has as its main objective the improvement of local fishing and associated environment and Anglers are honour bound to do all in their power to achieve this.
31. Any matters not provided for in these rules shall be decided on by the Greenfield Valley Trust, whose decision will be final and binding on all matters.
32. The water shall be closed to fishing for two consecutive weeks each year, such dates to be decided by the Greenfield Valley Trust and advised in advance.
33. Anglers have a duty of care toward safeguarding their own Health and Safety and Welfare, in particular with regard to Weil's Disease (Leptospirosis).
